Dave called into the One
Colchester Hub to ask about
volunteering opportunities with us
in the summer of 2019. He
enjoyed the atmosphere in the
Hub and wanted to be part of it.
He took up a role as a Hub front
desk volunteer and brought with
him skills from his experiences
volunteering for the Warm and
Toastie Club. He would greet
people as soon as they came in
and offer them a tea or coffee
which would immediately put
people at ease.

Dave became a big part of the One Colchester Hub, he regularly volunteered on our children's craft days, took slipper referrals, handed out winter packs and helped with events on weekends. He had some memory problems and said that staying active helped him with this.

He attended the 'My Weight Matters' group at the Hub to help him maintain a healthy lifestyle. But the major difference that volunteering made to his life was that he was not as isolated as he had once been he once said; "The Warm and Toastie Club saved my life, community360 gave my life meaning".

It was his own experiences with isolation that impassioned him to host a memory afternoon in the hub where he encouraged attendees who were at risk of isolation to talk about themselves and meet new people.

Sadly we have recently lost Dave but we will never forget his invaluable contributions to community360. His good humour and cheerful outlook were a huge part of the life and soul of the hub, he enjoyed Karaoke and would often fill silences with singing! Many volunteers and staff will have fond memories of his flamboyant fashion sense and eccentric taste in jewellery as well as his commitment to dressing up for International Tutu Day.

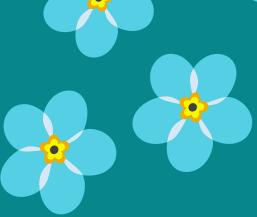
