A new and enhanced offer for unpaid carers in Essex will start in April.



The Carers Community Fund, funded by the Better Care Fund Allocation, aims to provide local community support for unpaid carers in Essex, offering digital services and refreshes of training opportunities.

The council is committed to providing information, advice, and support early in their caring role.

Organisations are collaborating to provide relevant support to unpaid carers, and **£1.75 million** has been allocated for local projects to support unpaid carers of all ages.
